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## FORMATTING

- No page limit for narrative
  - Use letter-size pages (8.5 x 11 inches) with a *minimum* of one-inch margins on the top, bottom, and both sides of every page
  - Use Arial, 11-point font
- 2 page limit for literature references
  - Use number formatting for literature references to reduce word count
- 2 page limit per investigator for biographical sketches
  - NIH-style is preferred (Form SF 424)

## SCIENTIFIC NARRATIVE

### PROJECT NARRATIVE COMPONENTS

Include details on preclinical evidence for selectivity of the radiotracer for alpha-synuclein, PK/PD data, a summary of any in vitro and in vivo testing done to date, a summary of available clinical data. Please include a summary and data to support fulfillment of the criteria to win the prize. Background on Parkinson's disease SHOULD NOT be included.

### SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- **Images and Figures:** supporting images or figures may be included within the narrative or as an appendix.
- **Videos:** a link to online videos may be included within the narrative.
- **Relevant articles:** please limit to published and 'in press' articles (defined as accepted at the time of application submission). Unpublished (or 'submitted') findings should be described in the application narrative, not attached as support.
