GP2 is leveraging The Michael J. Fox Foundation's (MJFF) grants infrastructure for this initiative. All full proposals must be submitted through the MJFF Grant Portal. If you have applied for funding through the MJFF Grant Portal, login using your credentials. If you need to reset your password, click the Forgot Password button.

GETTING STARTED – NEW GRANT PORTAL USERS

If you have never applied to an ASAP or MJFF RFA, click the "Register Here" button.

Search for your organization in the "Organization

Name" field. If your organization is not found, click "Add New Organization"

and complete the organization information.

Complete the "Contact Information" fields. Be sure to use an active email address.

Click the "Submit" button.

You will receive an email to the provided email address. Follow the instructions in that email to set a password and log in to the Grant Portal.

- University overhead costs (if applicable)
- Limited consumables with clear justification
- Participation in national and international conferences to engage with the global Parkinson's disease research community
